myOn Summer Library Program

Students and families will be encouraged to visit the E. J. Patten & Dr. H. N. Richardson Elementary Schools Library/Media Centers to engage in summer reading using the online library offered by myOn. Summer Reading Camp

The Summer Reading Camp program is intended to provide supplemental reading instruction during the summer for students in grades K-2 who are struggling with their reading skills. The program will have a focus on decoding skills, sight words, and reading strategies. The program will not only help students improve their reading ability but will also help minimize the effects of the so called “the summer slide” as students will receive four additional weeks of sustained and focused reading instruction.

Summer Math Camp

The Summer Math Camp program is intended to provide students in grades 3-5 reinforcement and review of grade level skills. The program will focus on conceptual understanding and problem-solving. Exposing students to real-world problem solving to build readiness for Common Core Assessments. Instructional formats will include direct, group, partner, and independent. Through the use of number names lessons, practice, games, and focused activities, the Summer Math Camp will help students improve their skills and understanding of mathematics at their grade level.

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Middle School Language Arts Enrichment Summer Program

Language Arts Enrichment Program aimed to promote literacy development for up to 80 students from S.E. Shull School and William C. McGinnis School s from June 29th – July 31st, 2015 , from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., at the S. E. Shull School.

Middle School Tier 3 (Intervention) Enrichment Summer Program

Up to 300 students from each middle school entering grades 6 -9 will be provided an opportunity for tier 3 enrichment instruction in core content subject area classes in which they were not academically successful during the school year. Program will run from July 1st - July 31st, 2015 from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., at the S. E. Shull School and William C. McGinnis School.

Algebra Summer Institute at Middlesex County College

The Algebra Summer Institute at Middlesex County College is for students who have completed sixth, seventh or eighth grade. The Institute is recommended for students interested in preparing for an Algebra I course. It is not a substitute for an Algebra I course. Students will explore algebraic concepts through hands-on activities and the integration of technology. The Institute is suggested for student enrichment and/or strengthening concepts.

Classes run July 6th – 30th, 2015, Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. A chaperone / teacher will travel on the bus with students and assist with instruction.

NJIT

The Center for Pre-College Programs at NJIT gives pre-college students the chance to explore careers in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) and to experience the relationship between these subjects and their applications to everyday life.

Approximately 60 students in grades 4 – 12 will attend the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) 2015 Summer Scholars' Program a "Pre-College Academy in Technology and Science" from July 6th - August 6th, 2015.

Project Adelante Summer 2015

80 students from Shull School, McGinnis School and Perth Amboy High School will continue their participation this summer in Project Adelante at Kean University. Academic instruction, counseling, enrichment and other support services in a 4-week summer academy. Dates: June 29th – July 23rd, 2015, Monday through Thursday.

New Jersey AIM High Academy Initiative Mathematics Project

40 Perth Amboy High School students will participate in the New Jersey AIM High Academy Initiative Mathematics Project at Kean University – a three week mathematical immersion residential summer program. Dates: June 29th – July 17th, 2015 . (At no cost to the Board funded through the College Access Challenge Grant and administered by New Jersey Higher Education)

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Kean University Summer S.T.E.M. Enrichment Program

32 Perth Amboy High School students will participate in the Summer STEM Program at PAHS and Kean University. The purpose of this program is to expose participating students to career clusters in the area of S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics). Students will experience the interdisciplinary connection between core content and S.T.E.M. areas through targeted projects including:

- Robotics
- Bio Feedback / Applied Physiology
- Resource sustainability
- S.T.E.M. related career opportunities
