The course is designed to follow one year of level II Drawing and Painting, adding to the student's art vocabulary and Drawing and Painting techniques. Focusing on creative expression, students are encouraged to stretch their imagination and communicate their ideas through further exploration of various art media.


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What Will I Learn in Drawing?



As an artist, I can integrate the characteristics of the tools of a selected media in original artworks to support artistic purposes.





Tonal range: Various shades of grey between absolute black and absolute white




As an artist, I can use hierarchy, proportion and overlapping to create depth in my artwork.


As an artist, I can emphasize the subject of my artwork and make it aesthetically pleasing to the viewer by how I arrange my composition.




What Will I Learn in Painting?



Color schemes: Monochromatic, Complementary, Triadic, Analogous, Split-Complementary



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Principles of Design:
Balance
Contrast

Color + white= Tint
Color + black= Shade
Color + gray= Tone

Intensity: The brightness or dullness of a color
Value: The lightness or darkness of a color

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


Ways to organize a composition:
Crossing
Repetition and rhythm
Balance (symmetrical, asymmetrical, and radial)

Students will continue to work on technical skills but at this level, focus is placed on creative expression and work that makes a visual statement. Assignments will be designed to meet the needs of the class or individual students. Students are encouraged to experiment on a larger scale, taking the time needed to produce significant works. Students will be required to do both objective, subjective and non objective pieces, manipulate space and mix media.

Los estudiantes continuarán trabajando en habilidades técnicas, pero en este nivel, el enfoque se pone en la expresión creativa y el trabajo que hace una declaración visual. Se requerirá que los estudiantes hagan piezas objetivas, subjetivas y no objetivas, manipulen el espacio y mezclen los medios.
