**BIKE DAY BY THE BAY** sets to provide a fun and educational experience on the importance of bike safety and the rules of the road when riding a bicycle on streets. This event is open for ages in kindergarten and up and all abilities. **BIKE DAY BY THE BAY** has two scheduled activities:

**THE BIKE RODEO:** a bicycle skills activity set to provide an opportunity for beginner bicyclists to practice and develop skills that will help them to become better bicyclists and avoid typical crashes. This activity is targeted for ages and abilities in kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

- **Registration:** Starts at 10:00AM
- **Bike Rodeo Activity Time:** 10:00AM -12:00PM
- **Location:** School playground (facing Smith Street) of the Dr. Herbert N. Richardson 21st Century Elementary School, located on 318 Stockton Street, Perth Amboy, NJ 08861
- **Requirements:** Bring your own bike and helmet
- **Giveaways:** Stickers (helmet decoration) and reflectors (for bicycles)

**THE COMMUNITY RIDE:** a fixed 4-mile route through the City of Perth Amboy led by the Perth Amboy Police Department. This activity is targeted for ages in 7<sup>th</sup> grade and up and intermediate riders.

- **Registration:** Starts at 12:00PM; Must sign pledge to ride safe
- **Community Ride:** 1:00PM-2:00PM, starting from 318 Stockton Street
- **Requirements:** Bring your own bike and helmet
- **Giveaways:** T-shirt and wristband for registered riders to be worn during the Community Ride
