This spring, schools across New Jersey will administer the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) in English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, and Science. The assessments for English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics will be administered to students in grades 3-9. The Science assessments will be administered to students in grades 5, 8, and 11.

The NJSLA assessments are statewide assessments that assess students' progress toward the New Jersey Student Learning Standards in ELA, mathematics, and science. The assessment is administered in a computer-based (CBT) format. Students will demonstrate their acquired skills and knowledge by answering selected-response items, constructed response items, and technology-enhanced questions.

With the goal of putting your child in the best position to put forth their best effort, we encourage parents to ensure that:

- 1. Your child is well rested.
- 2. Comes to school with a fully charged device.
- 3. Arrives to school on time each morning.
