


### First, this is how we learned to play the notes on a piano:


These are the finger numbers

This is Beethoven. Beethoven was born on December 1770 in Bonn, Germany. He passed away on March 26, 1827 at age 56 in Vienna, Austria. His longest symphony was 70 minutes long! Fun fact is that the song Ode To Joy was actually from a poem written by a guy named Friedrich Schiller. Beethoven took the poem and turned it into a symphony. Another fun fact, is that Mozart was Beethoven's piano teacher for a bit.




### Also, we have learned the spaces and lines on the Treble Clef.


How we remember the **spaces** is that it rhymes with **FACE**.
