





The Perth Amboy School District is pleased to announce that the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (NJSDA) has released the bid advertisement for the new Perth Amboy High School, the largest single school building undertaken in New Jersey by the NJSDA. *The new Perth Amboy High School will be designed to educate 2,800 students in grades 9 through 12 and constructed on the approximately 11.63-acre property on Convery Boulevard. The project scope calls for the construction of a three-story 576,000 square foot facility.*

The District has been busy over the past few months working with the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (NJSDA) on the building project. The new Perth Amboy High School continues to develop and move towards an official groundbreaking. Bi-weekly meetings are held with the District, the NJSDA, and the contractor (Terminal Construction Corporation) to discuss the progress of the site work, the use of fill materials for the site, the to-be-determined date for the ground opening, and the upcoming physical construction of the building. Bi-weekly meetings are also held between the District, the NJSDA, and the contractor to discuss specific items in more detail such as the locker numbering plan, the placement of automatic external defibrillators within the building, the design of an emergency generator, and the use of ice storage tanks for the building's HVAC system, which are all vital to the comfort, health, and safety of the students and staff. *The District is working to ensure that the needs of all its students and the community are taken into consideration and incorporated into the new high school, so that we continue providing our students with an education that is second to none. Stay tuned for more updates.*

El Distrito ha estado ocupado durante los últimos meses trabajando con la Autoridad de Desarrollo Escolar de Nueva Jersey, NJSDA por sus siglas en inglés, en el proyecto de construcción. La nueva Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy continúa desarrollándose y avanzando hacia el comienzo oficial de los trabajos de construcción. El Distrito, la NJSDA y el contratista (Terminal Construction Corporation) llevan a cabo reuniones quincenales para discutir el progreso de la obra, el uso de materiales de relleno, la fecha a determinar para la apertura del terreno y la construcción física del edificio. También se llevan a cabo reuniones quincenales entre el Distrito y la NJSDA para discutir temas específicos con más detalle, como el plan de numeración de casilleros, la colocación de los desfibriladores externos automáticos dentro del edificio, el diseño de un generador de emergencia y el uso de tanques de almacenamiento de hielo para el sistema HVAC del edificio, todos los cuales son vitales para la comodidad, salud y seguridad de nuestros estudiantes y personal. *El Distrito está trabajando para asegurarse que las necesidades de todos nuestros estudiantes y la comunidad se tomen en consideración y se incorporen a la nueva escuela secundaria para que continuemos brindando a nuestros estudiantes una educación insuperable. The new high school construction process is approaching the point where visible progress will be able to be seen daily at the site. The District website will soon contain a link to a live feed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, inviting the community to witness the progress of this historic building during construction of the largest school ever built by the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (NJSDA). As one can imagine, a project of this undertaking requires an enormous amount of planning, not only incorporating the needs of the District today, but also anticipating the needs of the District tomorrow. Weekly meetings continue to take place covering details as large as the heating and ventilation systems and as small as room names and paper towel dispensers. *Discussions about traffic patterns and parking, along with less complicated but equally important determinations regarding colors and patterns, are all a part of making the new high school historic, not just for its size, but also for the quality of education it will deliver, and the impact it will have to continuously raise the community to a higher level.* The last update about the school's progress is the magnitude of the details and planning that go into making this building as "green" as possible. From recycling policies, indoor environmental quality, water efficiency and renewable energy production, every detail is being considered to make this an environmentally safe and sustainable building. The District will continue to provide updates to the community and stakeholders and looks forward to opening the school as an accomplishment for all of Perth Amboy, past and present.

El proceso de construcción de la nueva escuela secundaria se acerca al punto en el que el progreso se podrá ver diariamente en la obra. El sitio web del Distrito pronto contendrá un enlace a una transmisión en vivo las 24 horas del día, los 7 días de la semana, invitando a la comunidad a presenciar el progreso de este edificio histórico durante la construcción de la escuela más grande jamás construida por la Autoridad de Desarrollo Escolar de Nueva Jersey, NJSDA por sus siglas en inglés. Como se puede imaginar, un proyecto de esta magnitud requiere una enorme cantidad de planificación, no sólo incorporando las necesidades del Distrito hoy, sino también anticipando las necesidades del Distrito mañana. Las reuniones semanales continúan ocurriendo para cubrir detalles tan grandes como los sistemas de calefacción y ventilación y tan pequeños como los nombres de los cuartos y los dispensadores de toallas de papel. *Las discusiones sobre los patrones de tráfico y el estacionamiento, junto con determinaciones menos complicadas, como la selección de colores y patrones, hacen que la nueva escuela secundaria sea histórica no sólo por su tamaño, sino también por la calidad de la educación que ofrecerá, y el impacto que tendrá en elevar continuamente a la comunidad a un nivel superior.* La última actualización sobre el progreso de la escuela es la magnitud de los detalles y la planificación que hacen que este edificio sea lo más "verde" posible. Desde las políticas de reciclaje, la calidad ambiental interior, la eficiencia del agua y la producción de energía renovable, cada detalle está siendo considerado para hacer de este, un edificio ambientalmente seguro y sostenible. El Distrito continuará proporcionando actualizaciones a la comunidad y espera con ansias abrir la escuela como un logro para todo Perth Amboy, pasado y presente.

As the community is aware, the New Jersey Schools Development Authority has collaborated with the Perth Amboy Board of Education to construct a new 576,000 square foot high school, which will be built on the site of the former Delaney Homes Housing Project. *Construction has begun and the community can see how the property has already been transformed from a barren plot of land with many holes, hills, and ditches to a smooth, level parcel with workers engaged every day. Perth Amboy, New Jersey – On Monday, September 27, 2021, Perth Amboy Public Schools, joined by students, state, county, and local officials participated in the groundbreaking ceremony hosted by the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (NJSDA).

The Groundbreaking Ceremony launched the next phase of the largest project undertaken by the NJSDA; a 576,000-square-foot, three-story facility with a total estimated cost of almost 300 million dollars. The new school is currently being constructed on an 11.63-acre site. The project is anticipated for completion and opening to students in September 2024. The construction of this highly anticipated school will result in a state-of-the-art facility for a maximum of 3,300 students in grades nine through twelve.

Some Points of Pride Algunos Puntos de Orgullo

The Perth Amboy School District was recognized as a Lighthouse District in 2019 by the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) for sustained growth and improvement. *El Distrito Escolar de Perth Amboy fue reconocido como Distrito Faro en el año 2019 por el Departamento de Educación del Estado de Nueva Jersey, NJDOE por sus siglas en inglés, por su crecimiento sostenido y mejora académica.*

The District's graduation rate increased from 59% in 2013 to 86% in 2022 as per the New Jersey Department of Education School Performance Report Card. As a result of the focus on student graduation, 969 more students have graduated over the past nine years compared to the number of students that would have graduated if the student graduation rate had stayed at 59%. *La tasa de graduación del Distrito aumentó del 59% en el año 2013 al 86% en el año 2022 según el Informe de Desempeño Escolar del Departamento de Educación de Nueva Jersey de 2021-2022. Como resultado del enfoque en la graduación de los estudiantes, 969 estudiantes más se han graduado en comparación al número de estudiantes que se hubieran graduado si la tasa de graduación se hubiera quedado en 59%.*

According to the 2021-2022 US News and World Report Ranking of High Schools, Perth Amboy High School (PAHS) was ranked 247 out of 406 New Jersey high schools and 7,431 out of 17,843 public high schools in the nation. *Según la clasificación de escuelas secundarias llevada a cabo por US News and World Report 2021-2022, la Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy ocupó el puesto 247 entre 406 escuelas secundarias de Nueva Jersey y el puesto 7,431 de 17,843 escuelas secundarias públicas del país.*

PAHS moved up 2,240 spots from 2020 to 2022 and 529 spots from 2021 to 2022 in the national ranking. *La Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy subió 2,240 puestos desde el año 2020 al año 2022 y 529 puestos desde el año 2021 al año 2022 en el ranking nacional.*

PAHS moved up 57 spots from 2020 to 2022 and 12 spots from 2021 to 2022 in the New Jersey ranking. *La Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy subió 57 puestos desde el año 2020 al año 2022 y 12 puestos desde el año 2021 al año 2022 en el ranking de Nueva Jersey.*

The introduction of small learning communities in 2018-2019 allowed students to have a focus on their academic pursuits while demonstrating significant growth. *La introducción de pequeñas comunidades de aprendizaje en el año escolar 2018-2019 permitió a los estudiantes centrarse en sus actividades académicas que también han demostrado un crecimiento significativo.*

The graduation rates for the Communications Academy have shown a remarkable progression, starting from 95.8% in 2021, increasing to 98.6% in 2022, and achieving 100% in 2023. *Las tasas de graduación de la Academia de Comunicaciones han mostrado una progresión notable, comenzando con 95.8% en el año 2021, aumentando a 98.6% en el año 2022 y alcanzando el 100% en el año 2023.*

The graduation rate for the Health Sciences Academy Class of 2022 was 100%. *La tasa de graduación de la Academia de Ciencias de la Salud del año 2022 fue de un 100%.*

In 2022, there were 12 students who graduated with an Emergency Medical Responder or Certified Personal Trainer Certification. In 2023, that number increased 150% with 30 students graduating with these certifications. *En el año 2022, 12 estudiantes que se graduaron con una certificación de Respondedor Médico de Emergencia o Entrenador Personal Certificado. En el año 2023, esta cifra aumentó un 150% con 30 estudiantes que se graduaron con estas certificaciones.*

The New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) scores for Instruction and Program increased from 32% in 2014 to 79% as per the last QSAC review in 2023. *Los puntajes QSAC en el área de Instrucción y Programas aumentaron del 32% en el año 2014 al 79% según la última evaluación de QSAC en el año 2023.*

The District established the first stand-alone public Dual Language School in the State of New Jersey. The District has a Dual Language Program for students in grades PreK-8 and a Biliteracy Program for students in grades 9-12. *El Distrito estableció la primera escuela pública independiente de educación dual en el estado de Nueva Jersey. El Distrito tiene un programa de educación dual para estudiantes en los grados PreK-8 y un programa de alfabetización bilingüe para estudiantes en los grados 9-12.*

The number of students who earned the New Jersey Seal of Biliteracy increased from 37 in 2015 to 299 in 2023. *El número de estudiantes que obtuvieron el Sello de Alfabetización Bilingüe de Nueva Jersey aumentó de 37 en el año 2015 a 299 en el año 2023.*



The District's inclusion rate of 59.04% surpassed the state inclusion rate of 45% as per the Local District Special Education Report for the 2021-2022 school year. La tasa de inclusión del Distrito de 59.04% superó la tasa de inclusión estatal de 45% según el Informe de Educación Especial del Distrito del año escolar 2021-2022.

The District's participation rate for PSAT increased from 24.7% in the 2020-2021 school year to 76.7% in the 2021-2022 school year as per the NJDOE District Performance Report. La tasa de participación del Distrito en la prueba PSAT aumentó del 24.7% en el año escolar 2020-2021 al 76.7% en el año escolar 2021-2022 según el Informe de Desempeño del Distrito generado por el Departamento de Educación de Nueva Jersey.

The 2021-2022 District participation rate for the SAT was 90.7%, which is 29.9% higher than the state average of 60.8%, as per the 2021-2022 NJDOE District Performance Report. La tasa de participación del Distrito en la prueba SAT del año escolar 2021-2022 fue del 90.7%, es decir, un 29.9% más alto que el promedio estatal de 60.8% según el Informe de Desempeño del Distrito del Departamento de Educación de Nueva Jersey del año escolar 2021-2022.

On September 11, 2023, the District was selected, by the NJDOE and Governor Murphy as one of the eleven districts to receive a combined \$15 million grant to expand school-based mental health services for students. El 11 de septiembre de 2023, el Distrito fue seleccionado por el Departamento de Educación de Nueva Jersey y el Gobernador Murphy como uno de los once distritos merecedores de una subvención combinada de \$15 millones para ampliar los servicios de salud mental de los estudiantes.

The District's Early Childhood Centers received an average score of 6.14 in the ECERS assessment tool in the 2021-2022 school year, which exceeded the state average 4.17. Los Centros de Educación Pre-Escolar del Distrito obtuvieron un puntaje promedio de 6.14 en la evaluación ECERS en el año escolar 2021-2022, mientras que el puntaje promedio del estado fue de 4.17.

Perth Amboy High School was recognized as a National Banner Unified Champion School through the Special Olympics, an honor given to schools that demonstrate a commitment to inclusion and excellence. La Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy fue reconocida como Escuela Campeona Nacional Unificada a través de las Olimpiadas Especiales, un honor otorgado a las escuelas que demuestran un compromiso con la inclusión y la excelencia.

Regarding the maintenance of the District's facilities, the District has achieved the following objectives: Con respecto al mantenimiento de las instalaciones, el Distrito ha logrado los siguientes objetivos:

After fifteen years of stagnate movement, the District, in coordination with the New Jersey Schools Development Authority, was able to successfully facilitate the construction of the new \$300,000,000 Perth Amboy High School set to open in the early Spring of 2024. 
Logistical Planning for the New High School

Planificación Logística para la Nueva Escuela Secundaria

There is a great deal of planning taking place behind the scenes as the District works diligently towards opening the new high school. *One item of importance that has been at the forefront of recent discussions is pedestrian safety and traffic management around the new high school. The District, along with the City of Perth Amboy, and the State Department of Transportation are actively discussing ideas to help ensure travel to and from the new high school is safe for everyone. Two high-level meetings have occurred, with several scenarios and ideas shared among everyone. The primary focus of the discussions is centered around finding ways to slow traffic around Convery Boulevard while finding ways to raise awareness to the general public to cross the street at designated "corner" points.* The District will continue to work with the city and state to ensure these safety measures are enacted well before the high school opens in September 2024. As logistical planning continues, the District has also had several discussions about how to effectively maneuver within the new high school in order to work more efficiently. One item of discussion has been finding ways to help the security, custodial, and other pertinent staff travel from one side of the building to another as quickly as possible in case of an emergent situation. The District is looking at the possibility of purchasing "Segway" units and golf carts for staff to reduce the time it takes to traverse the building. To reach several large ceiling areas, the District has also discussed purchasing "scissor lifts" that would allow the custodial and maintenance teams to conduct simple tasks like changing a light bulb without having to request the assistance of an outside company. These are just a few examples of the discussions that are taking place behind the scenes. The District will continue to share what it is doing as it prepares for what will be one of the largest high schools ever built by the New Jersey Schools Development Authority.

Hay una gran cantidad de planificación que se está llevando a cabo detrás de escena mientras el Distrito trabaja diligentemente para abrir la nueva escuela secundaria. *Un tema de importancia que ha estado en el centro de las discusiones recientes es la seguridad de los peatones y el patrón de tráfico alrededor de la nueva escuela secundaria. El Distrito escolar, junto con la Ciudad de Perth Amboy y el Departamento de Transporte del Estado, están discutiendo activamente ideas para ayudar a garantizar que viajar desde y hacia la nueva escuela secundaria sea seguro para todos. Dos reuniones de alto nivel han ocurrido durante las cuales se compartieron y discutieron varios escenarios e ideas. El enfoque principal de las discusiones se centró en encontrar formas de reducir la velocidad del tráfico alrededor de Convery Boulevard y al mismo tiempo, encontrar formas de garantizar que el público en general crucé la calle en los puntos designados como las "esquinas."* El Distrito escolar continuará trabajando con la ciudad y el estado para garantizar que estas medidas de seguridad se implementen mucho antes de que la escuela secundaria abra en septiembre de 2024. A medida que continúa la planificación logística, el Distrito también ha tenido varias discusiones sobre cómo desplazarse efectivamente dentro de la nueva escuela secundaria para poder trabajar de manera más eficiente. Un tema de discusión ha sido encontrar formas de ayudar al personal de seguridad, conserjería y otro personal pertinente a desplazarse de un lado a otro del edificio lo más rápido posible en caso de una situación emergente. El Distrito está considerando la posibilidad de comprar unidades "Segway" y carritos de golf para que el personal reduzca el tiempo que lleva recorrer el edificio. Para llegar a varias áreas donde los techos son altos, el Distrito también ha discutido la compra de "elevadores de tijera" que permitirán a nuestros equipos de conserjería y mantenimiento realizar tareas simples como cambiar una bombilla de luz sin tener que solicitar la asistencia de una empresa externa. Estos son sólo algunos ejemplos de las discusiones que se están llevando a cabo tras bambalinas. El Distrito continuará compartiendo lo que está haciendo mientras se prepara para lo que será una de las escuelas secundarias más grandes jamás construida por la Autoridad de Desarrollo Escolar de Nueva Jersey.



Furniture Selection Process for the New Perth Amboy High School

The District is in the process of selecting furniture for the 576,000 square feet of space in the new Perth Amboy High School. The furniture selection process is programmatically driven. A variety of collaborators have met in sub-committees and engaged in collegial conversations about the furniture selection process. *The core of these conversations kept the best interests of students, teachers, leaders, staff, and the community at the forefront. The teams strategically searched for furniture designs that align with 21st century learning principles and are adaptable to meet the needs of all students and staff now and in years to come. Members of the Office of Curriculum and Instruction and Perth Amboy High School building administration were involved in recommending furniture options for both general and specialized spaces such as classrooms, offices, media center, special education and visual and performing art areas.* The District is working closely with the New Jersey Schools Development Authority to finalize the furniture that will furnish the building. “As part of this process, we do not only want to secure furniture that is durable and high quality, but we also must consider that each piece is functional, versatile, and innovative, so that students can feel comfortable and engaged in their learning environment” – Dr. Damián O. Medina, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction.

El Distrito está en el proceso de seleccionar el mobiliario para los 576,000 pies cuadrados de espacio de la nueva Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy. El proceso de selección de muebles está impulsado por nuestros programas e iniciativas curriculares. Un grupo diverso de miembros interesados se han reunido en subcomités y han participado en conversaciones colegiales sobre el proceso de selección de muebles. *El núcleo de estas conversaciones mantuvo en primer plano las necesidades de los estudiantes, los maestros, los líderes, el personal y la comunidad. Los equipos buscaron estratégicamente diseños de muebles que se alinean con los principios de aprendizaje del siglo XXI y que son adaptables para satisfacer las necesidades de todos los estudiantes y el personal ahora y en los años por venir. Los miembros de la Oficina de Currículo e Instrucción y la administración de la actual Escuela Secundaria de Perth Amboy participaron en la recomendación de opciones de mobiliario para espacios generales y especializados, como las aulas generales, oficinas, centro de medios, espacios de educación especial y áreas de artes visuales y escénicas.* El Distrito está trabajando en colaboración con la Autoridad de Desarrollo Escolar para identificar los muebles que llenaran el edificio. “Como parte de este proceso, no sólo queremos conseguir muebles que sean duraderos y de alta calidad, sino que también debemos considerar que cada pieza sea funcional, versátil e innovadora, para que los estudiantes puedan sentirse cómodos e involucrados en su entorno de aprendizaje” – Dr. Damián O. Perth Amboy High School Graduation Rate





Similar to the sustained growth of students graduating high school, the number of students graduating with the Seal of Biliteracy consistently increased over the years as well. Back in 2015, only 37 students graduated with the Seal of Biliteracy. These numbers have gradually increased each year leading to 259 students receiving the Seal of Biliteracy in 2022, and 299 are projected to receive the Seal of Biliteracy for the 2022-2023 school year, pending the release of the New Jersey School Performance Report. *These numbers speak to Perth Amboy's commitment to bilingual and dual language education. As a District, we fully embrace the opportunity to promote biliteracy and bilingualism among our students. The District sees students' native language as an asset that can help forge academic achievement, equity, and inclusion.*





