Dear Construction Industry Professional:

At the onset of 2017, as we look forward to a productive year ahead, I thought it was a good time to reach out to the Contracting Community to share some highlights of the past year for the school construction program, and most importantly focus on upcoming work and strongly encourage your participation in the program.

In 2016, we delivered approximately 1.25 million square feet of new construction representing a total State investment of \$553 million. This good work, which resulted in the Important delivery of over 8,500 new seats to New Jersey school children, was performed by NJSDA Prequalified Contractors and Design/Builders and their subs, and was overseen by engaged Construction Management firms. We also awarded new work valued in excess of \$275 million.

We are very excited about our projections for 2017, and I have enclosed a copy of our advertisement forecast for the year.



We plan to advertise Construction Work valued at between \$500 and \$600 million this year.

Among the significant projects we expect to advertise are:

- New Educational Campus in Passaic City (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$150-\$160M)
- New High School in Perth Amboy (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$180-\$200M)
- New Middle School in Paterson (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$50-\$60M)
- New Elementary School in Pemberton (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$40-\$50M)
- New Elementary School in Plainfield (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$40-\$50M)
- New Elementary School in East Orange (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$20-\$30M)

In addition, work advertised at the end of 2016 that will be awarded in 2017 includes:

Addition/Renovation to the Millville Senior High School (Construction Cost Estimate Range: \$90-\$100M)
