- Not be directly/indirectly interested in any contract with or claim against the Board.
- Not hold office as Mayor or a member of the municipal governing body.
- Not disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1.

The successful candidate must fulfill the requirements of the New Jersey School Ethics Act and satisfy a criminal history background check pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1.

The appointment will be effective until the Organization Meeting following the November 2020 annual school election.
