

We are so excited to welcome you back to a new school year filled with the promise of learning in a safe, exciting and bilingual learning environment.

To view your child's teacher, room number, and class schedule, please log into the Parent Portal on Infinite Campus at https://perthnj.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/parents/perthamboy.jsp. Please register if you have not done so already. You may check the Parent Portal regularly to stay informed of your child's progress throughout the school year.

Some important information as we prepare for the school's opening:

- First Day of School is on Thursday, September 4, 2025.
- Gates open at 8:10 am, school starts at 8:35 am, and dismissal is at 3:00 pm
- Breakfast is served after the 8:35 am bell inside the classrooms.
- Anyone picking up your child MUST have a photo ID.
- To ensure the safety of our school community, all individuals entering the building will pass through our security checkpoint. All visitors MUST have identification.
- Regular school attendance is essential to your child's academic success and overall development.
- School uniforms are required. Click here for information on school uniforms.
- To determine if your child is eligible for free or reduced-priced meals, you must complete a lunch application every year. You can complete the lunch application online through **Parent Portal** or by downloading a paper application from our school website.
- Clearly mark your child's name and room number on the label inside the sweater, jacket or coat. This will help us to return the item(s) to the correct student if it is lost.
- If your child needs to be picked up early before 3:00 pm, please notify the main office by 2:00 pm. Any student released early must be picked up prior to 2:30 pm. For safety precautions, any time after this will interfere with our regular dismissal process.
- We cannot release your child to a contact that is not on your emergency list.
- Transportation will be offered for any K-12 students who live 2 or more miles from their school and for high school students who live 2.5 miles from the high school. In addition, transportation will continue to be provided to students in the following schools or programs:
 - o Special Education, as per Individualized Education Programs
 - o Students experiencing homelessness, as required by McKinney-Vento
 - o Bilingual Students attending a school other than their neighborhood school
- Kindergarten Orientation will be held on Tuesday, September 2nd, from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
- Back-to-School Night will be held on Monday, September 29th, from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm.
