This model builds on and strengthens a culture that supports learning and affords every educator an opportunity to enrich his/her practice.

The District Professional Development Plan provides guidance and a menu of professional development opportunities throughout the year for staff. Professional development will be an ongoing process that involves sustainable improvement with learning loss during the pandemic for our students learning and instructional practices. This requires evaluation of student performance and teacher self-assessment, identifying possible courses of action, testing new approaches, assessing results, and then beginning the process anew.

The district's approach to professional development is to make certain that all educators have the best possible skills, content knowledge, and preparation for effective teaching and learning. The needs of learners in the twenty-first century, along with the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS), demand innovative, progressive, and cutting-edge professional development through a variety of formats such as in-service training, workshops, webinars, and coaching, modeling, and professional learning communities.

Professional development opportunities will be offered throughout the 2022-2023 school year during

- Summer months
- Three professional development days built into the district calendar September and October 2022
- Two school-based after school staff meetings per month one 75-minute session and one 60-minute session
- Embedded PLC time
- After school and Saturdays as needed
- District catalog offering in-district and out-of-district professional development opportunities throughout the school year
