Simple Solutions to Behavioral Problems

- 1. Everyone in the family agree on a discipline plan
- 2. Setup a routine that you can follow
- 3. Give Choices
- 4. Praise Good Behavior
- **5. Rewards** <u>Social Rewards</u>: smiles, hugs, attention, <u>Activity Rewards</u>: go to the park, play a game <u>Material Rewards</u>: ice cream, ball, book
- 6. Ignore inappropriate behaviors that are not dangerous
- 7. Consequences
- 8. Give Warnings
- 9. As a child gets louder you get lower and make sure you that you have their attention
- 10. The Key to Simple Solutions is being consistent.






Vaccinations

- Vaccines Required
 - Flu Shots
 - All Preschool Students must have obtained the flu shot and submit the appropriate paperwork by December 21st. If not, the child will be excluded from school until they bring the proper documentation.

Attendance and Tardies

- Arrival and Dismissal Procedures
