




# José Guadalupe Posada 1852–1913 – Mexican

Jose was a printmaker whose artwork often showed hardworking Mexican people.

Posada's most famous illustration is "*La Calavera de la Catrina*", an image that is now remembered during the Mexican holiday Día de los Muertos.




" La Calavera de la Catrina" 1913



# Candido Bido, 1936-2011 Dominican Republic

He was the first painter from DR to exhibit in France. Famous for his blazing yellows, turquoise-sea blues and fiery shades of orange.




# Frida Kahlo, 1907–1954 – Mexican


Known for painting her self portraits.

## Self Portrait, 1934




## "Self Portrait along the Border between Mexico and USA" -1932

 Cubism takes natural shape and reduces it into basic geometric parts. Picasso focused on creating forms like cylinders, spheres and cones to represent the natural world.





"Three Musicians" 1921 – Cubist Period




# Mia Roman Hernandez (Puerto Rico)
