B. Board President's Report – Mr. Kenneth Puccio

- Mr. Puccio offered condolences to those staff members who have lost a member of their family over the last month.
- Mr. Puccio stated that all good things are happening within our district and it's because of the hard work our central administration, our staff and board members are doing.

C. Superintendent's Report – Dr. David A. Roman

- The high school junior class expressed a desire to have a trip instead of a prom. Principal Rodriguez met with the representatives of the junior class and discussed the issue. Students conducted a survey and 85% voted to have a trip instead. The trip is scheduled for May 26, 2018.
- We have made progress on the renovation of the high school weight room; however, we have run into an issue. Mr. Jess explained that the weight room was outdated and is currently being renovated. Our Facilities Director, Mr. Crupi and his maintenance staff have begun to renovate the interior of the weight room with new bathrooms, new HVAC and have painted the interior to bring it up to date, however, they ran into a problem while removing the floor and it is being corrected. Mr. Cardona, Director of Athletics, purchased new weightlifting and cardio equipment and if the weight room is not complete when it is delivered, it will be set up at another location. Once complete, we will be relocate the equipment back into the renovated weight room.

- Mr. Iglesia thanked those staff members who are retiring for their service and said that when we have a high number of people resigning it has a negative effect on the district. There are high costs associated with training new staff, a lower base of knowledge, and limited experience in meeting job expectations and accomplishing our goals to be the best in New Jersey. This is very concerning. In February: 5 people retired and 11 resigned. In March: 5 people retired and 9 resigned. In April: 6 people are retiring and 9 people are resigning. That's 45 people who have left the district over the last 3 months. Mr. Iglesia recommends that we review data to study why people are exiting the district.
