5. Student Representative – Charlize Leon

Ms. Leon discussed her journey as an immigrant and for Teacher’s Appreciation Week, thanked all teachers for making her acceptance and transition possible. She provided updates on athletic events, art, music, college decisions of seniors, and senior awards. Ms. Leon then relayed information about the Humvee provided by the National Guard for the automotive classes to work on. She welcomed incoming Freshman and commented on the bittersweet end of the school year for seniors.

6. Presentation

▪ Public Hearing for the proposed 2022-2023 Budget – Dr. David A. Roman and Mr. Michael LoBrace
Dr. Roman and Mr. LoBrace presented the budget for Fiscal Year 2023. Dr. Roman reinforced the idea that Curriculum and Programs drive the budget. Dr. Roman presented an overview of all planned curriculum, programs, and initiatives. Mr. LoBrace provided numbers and budgetary data.
Ms. Yolanda Gomez presented on the Job Fair and updates on all District ongoing hiring efforts.

Ms. Vazquez noted the changes from the draft budget to the final budget presented tonight, the tax levy and fiscal responsibility.

Mr. Iglesia noted his agreement with the 0% tax levy increase. He welcomed and thanked the Superintendent for his recommendation.

Ms. Gonzalez commended Dr. Neu for her hard work and creative thoughts for the advances the District is making in Special Services.

Mr. Anderson asked for clarification and assurances there would be no increase in taxes and Dr. Roman reiterated a 0% increase. Mr. Anderson also requested clarification on the dollar amount estimated, as the average increase per household property. The Acting School Business Administrator explained the method for calculating the increase.

President Puccio discussed the budget and tax levy. He thanked the Finance Committee for the work they put into the budget and the input provided, which led to no increase.

Mr. Iglesia noted the SDA regulations and read a statement on Local Fair Share calculations and purpose.

Ms. Gonzalez discussed the importance of seizing the opportunities in front of the Board of Education to ensure student achievement and the quality of education provided is at the forefront.

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The Board discussed the effect and necessity of a 2% tax levy increase which was not included in the final budget total, and the need for additional funding sources in lieu of. The Board was provided information regarding supply inventories being revisited due to an anticipated reduction in supply needs, while being reflected in the budget.



Due to advances in communication technology, the Board has the capacity to permit remote attendance at board meetings on a limited basis through the use of electronic devices. Therefore, the Board authorizes that a Board member may participate in a board meeting from a remote location through the use of an electronic device according to the following guidelines:

- A. The Board member determines there is a good reason why they cannot physically attend the meeting;
- B. Notice of the remote participation is made in advance of the meeting to the Board President;
- C. An electronic connection is available and is sufficient to be heard by the public; and

The Board member must access the meeting using the video and / or telephone conferencing platform provided by the Board. Remote participation of a member shall be announced to the public and recorded in the meeting minutes at the roll call.

Board members approved to participate in a board meeting from a remote location through an electronic device shall be counted in the quorum. The electronic connection must be audible to the public and in the same location as the meeting.

Any remotely participating member will be considered absent for all or part of the meeting as appropriate, if the electronic connection is or becomes insufficient to be heard by the public; if the transmission is terminated due to equipment or power failure or poor connection; or any other reason that jeopardizes the public's access to information at the meeting in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act. The members absence shall be duly noted in the minutes including the time and circumstances regarding the termination of the member's participation.

Under no circumstances shall a Board member be allowed to participate in a Board meeting from a remote location without prior notice. No Board member shall be permitted to participate remotely on a routine or consistent basis. Remote participation by electronic device in closed executive session is prohibited.

0167. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN BOARD MEETINGS

The Board of Education recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express themselves in-person and remote on school matters of community interest.

In order to permit the fair and orderly expression of such comment, the Board shall set aside a portion of every Board meeting, the length of the portion to be determined by the Board, for public comment on any school or school district issue that a member of the public feels may be of concern to the residents of the school district.

Public participation shall be governed by the following rules:

1. A participant must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface comments by an announcement of his/her name, municipality of residence, and group affiliation, if applicable;
2. After in-person participants have concluded their comments, the Board will welcome comments from remote participants. Remote participants must state their full name and municipality. The Board shall not accept text-based public comment, unless an accommodation is made in advance. Remote participants must access the meeting using the video and / or telephone conferencing platform provided by the Board which must have a function that allows the Board to regulate participation and mute the audio, as well as allows remote participants to mute themselves. Regulation of conduct by remote participants shall be consistent with law and Board practices;
3. Each statement made by a participant shall be limited to three minutes' duration;
4. No participant may speak more than once on the same topic until all others who wish to speak on that topic have been heard;
5. All statements, questions, or inquiries shall be directed to the presiding officer and any questions or inquiries directed by a participant to another Board member shall be redirected to the presiding officer who shall determine if such statement, question, or inquiry shall be addressed by the presiding officer on behalf of the Board or by the individual Board member;
6. The presiding officer may:

- a. Interrupt, warn, and/or terminate a participant's statement, question, or inquiry when it is too lengthy;
- b. Interrupt and/or warn a participant when the statement, question, or inquiry is abusive, obscene, or may be defamatory;
- c. Request any person to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum;
- d. Request the assistance of school law enforcement officers or law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person prevents or disrupts a meeting with an act that obstructs or interferes with a meeting;
- e. Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting; and
- f. Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or to maintain an orderly operation of the Board meeting.
