- Dr. Roman said he cannot speak about personnel or staff issues, but he can speak about how the people who spoke. The quality and dignity of what the social worker does and their compassion is evident. When we have issues, we have to make sure we are in compliance with code because currently we are not. These discussions were not made in a vacuum. The principals, special education, both assistant superintendents and human resources were involved.
- Mr. Rodriguez stated that the schools don't have a dedicated Child Study Team. The changes that we're doing will allow our schools to have this dedicated Child Study Team. We're not in compliance with the LDTC requirements now. These moves will allow us to be in compliance. These people can apply for the new positions, but they cannot provide what we need now in accordance with the statues.
- The positions we're looking to fill are a Autism Specialist, Social Workers for the Child Study Team, School Psychologist, SACS and Counselors.
- Dr. Rodriguez stated that the plan will provide two counselors at each elementary school and a psychologist as well. The services will still be provided.
- Mr. Chromey said with regards to responsive classrooms, it's a plan we're putting forward that will allow us to move forward with this initiative. We trying to address the heavy load of our Child Study Team members.
- Mrs. McAdam said this is not a determination of who can do what. In looking at the data there are behavioral issues in the pre-schools and elementary schools. The school psychologist in a non-traditional role. When we spoke with the principals that is what they said they needed. Special Education is faced with not having enough workers to manage the students. Case Managers and Counselors serve certain kids. We want to consolidate these two and have them better manage the students. It's different when you talk about a plan and it involves people. We do not currently have full child Study Teams in each school. The current Child Study Teams travel between schools and this will hopefully stop.

- Mr. Iglesia mentioned that in FY16 there was \$30,000,000 transferred to capital reserve at the end of the year and we had a tax rate of \$22,700,000. In FY17 we had apparently transferred \$20,000,000 to capital reserve and our tax rate was \$25,200,000. This year with our budget decreasing we were proposing to use \$42,000,000 in surplus and have our taxes increase to \$28,000,000. We put more than \$50,000,000 into capital reserve and we have more than \$48,000,000 in surplus. Due to the efficiencies which with our budgets have been created and monitored he believes that there will be additional surplus monies moving forward and we don't have to raise taxes on our hard working people. We have to do something about this. Every time we raise taxes the cost of living in our community goes up and everyone suffers. He would like to have the surplus go from \$42,000,000 to \$40,000,000.
- Ms. Vazquez stated that we didn't receive any budget information until Friday and it was just discussed today. We have time constraints and it must be passed today.
- Mr. Iglesia said we have Robert's Rules of Order we must follow. Therefore there should be a motion and a second on the new motion which is the new one on the table.
- Ms. Vazquez said if the surplus was \$42,000,000 why are we increasing it.
- Mr. Jess stated that we received additional state aid in July that we did not use this year, so we're going to use it next year.
- Mrs. Machado said if the board doesn't approve the budget tonight the county will review what's been submitted and approve that budget. The county will approve what was last submitted.
- Mr. Puccio asked if there was a tax increase what would it be.
- Mr. Jess said \$113.00 a year.
- Mr. Puccio replied that would be about .31 cents a day. The state is providing us with \$250,000,000 for a new high school, \$55,000,000 for a new elementary school and 85% of our general fund money comes from state aid, which roughly translates to \$499,000,000 in total. Our tax payers have benefited for years from us being a special district. We need to make a decision and then vote.
- Mr. Massopust asked are we in jeopardy for us by not voting on the budget tonight.
- Ms. Machado said yes, it will be taken out of the boards hands.
- Mr. Massopust asked if the board votes on it will the students be hurt by this.
- Ms. Machado said she's not sure, she believes that the administration worked a budget that will provide for a thorough and efficient education.
- Ms. Lebron asked if the administration has done their due diligence with regards to the tax increase. We trust in the administration and need to know where we stand. We don't want to jeopardize the programs discussed tonight. Some items are locked in, but others may not.
- Mr. Iglesia said the Finance Committee has not discussed the budget to this point.

- It was stated that the discomfort in this conversation tonight was the superintendent's and he apologizes. Any cuts will have a progamatic impact on students. Past practice dedicated how this procedure was done and it's the understanding that in the past the Finance Committee was provided with what they were provided with and no formal meetings happened, however moving forward we can certainly change the process. We get a lot of money from the state. We've done lots of due diligence and everyone has insured that this is what we need to run the programs which is why it was put forward.
- Mr. Iglesia said if we do our due diligence and research the budget we can continue to do what we need to do without raising taxes.
- What would you cut because the leaders have said this is what they need.
- Ms. Vazquez said this is not how is was done in the past. We didn't have time to review it. We can't make cuts to programs today. There may be a programmatic issue with some of these budget changes.
- Dr. Roman stated that we did not have the Finance Committee Meeting because of a death in his family. There was a portion of this discussed at the Finance Committee Meeting.
- Mr. Puccio said if the second motion made does not pass, does it still go to the County Superintendent. Mrs. Machado said yes.
- Mr. Iglesia made a motion to amend the proposed budget by reducing the proposed tax increase by \$2,000,000 so that there will be no increase in taxes. The total amount of the revised budget will be \$281,476,506. The motion was seconded by Ms. Lebron.

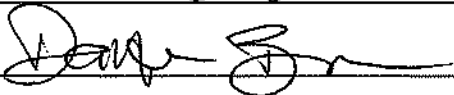

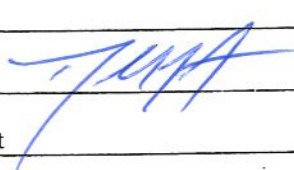

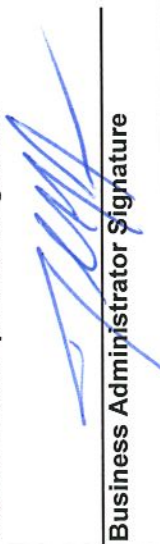

The under spend in salaries is a result of staffing changes and vacancies for the staff during the year creating variances in salary amounts. The excess spend in benefits is a result of more than budgeted staff taking on benefits. The budget is prepared prior to benefit renewal period and so benefit estimates are based on prior year. If there is a different mix of teaching staff or a change in benefit need, as there was this year, we experience the variances in benefit line items.
We are requesting a budget modification to transfer funds in the direct expense categories from classroom supplies and technologies to substitute stipends. The under spend in supplies and technology-primarily technology is a result of our technology spend being picked up as a corporate wide expense. All of our technology is covered on a corporate wide spend basis and is not allocated direct to each site. Any direct computer/ipad charges that would typically be charged to site already were purchased in prior year - we have what is needed for the current year already in place. For Sub Teacher Stipend, the budget is prepared prior to grant period and we do not know at that time the what coverages we will need for teacher absences. Also this is a fixed amount at the budget prep period and not adjusted until such time at budget modifications occur.
Finally we are requesting a budget modification to transfer funds in the direct expense categories from Floater and Family Worker (Asst. Floater and Family Worker Salary and Benefits) to Indirect Utilities expense. The under spend in floater and Family Worker is a result of staffing changes and vacancies for the staff during the year creating variances in salary amounts. The budget is prepared prior to benefit renewal period and so benefit estimates are based on prior year.

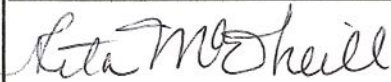

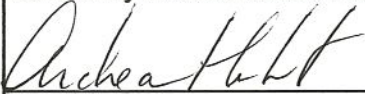

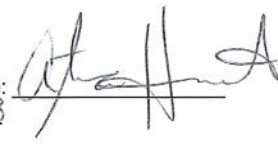
