- Public member #1 - Appeared to advocate for her son who was part of an incident at Shull Middle School and expressed her concerns for the incident. She also expressed concern for the morning school entry and accessibility. She then presented a list of questions she would like responses to.
- Public member #2 - Discussed the need to help teachers be more effective by having less work and less responsibilities with a lighter workload to do the real work of education without the white noise.
- Public member #3 - Questioned if the Unified Sports stipends should be negotiated and is requesting documentation and her displeasure at the recruitment committee criteria. She agrees there is a need for a committee and asked for more information.
- Public member #4 - Discussed communication between parents and the district. She also wants the district to search for ways to be creative to limit sports cancellations due to the pandemic. Her request was for the district to have someone available to communicate with parents and provide responses.

- Public member #5 - Stated she was present to speak for several reasons. The Perth Amboy Historic Society would like an update to the archway at Water Stadium, a concern for the Board meeting information not being easy to find on the website and the length of time for tonight's Executive Session.
- Public member #6 - Expressed concerns about the lack of transportation for athletics and the need for communication. She believes in the need for athletics and the role it plays for our students. She expressed the need for some teachers which still are not hired for vacant positions.

B. Board President's Report – Mr. Kenneth Puccio

President Puccio read the bereavement announcements. The President commented on the archway and he indicated he and the Superintendent met with the Historical society.

C. Superintendent's Report – Dr. David A. Roman

The Superintendent announced there would be changes to the 21-22 school calendar presented tonight including the observance of Juneteenth.

He continued discussing the importance of coming back from remote and the cautionary prudent approach the District pursued with coordination from the County, State and Health Department. He explained the vast array of information being provided from different agencies and governments and their competing objectives which all need to be navigated.

He addressed the concerns of the parents who presented concerns and requested Directors and Principals to meet with those parents and address their concerns and report back.

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Students cannot enter buildings without appropriate staff present, but opportunities will be made available for extra pay if teachers are willing to be there.

The Superintendent clarified the creation of the committee to give teachers new experiences while helping the District. He addressed the Unified Sports stipend and gave the correct amount.

The District tries to provide transportation in all instances as long as they meet the criteria of the District.

The archway is a safety concern and the resources cannot be reused for construction, but a small structure is being considered on the side of the entrance to preserve some of the historic aspects.

An update was given regarding the new HS. The Superintendent confirmed the website does in fact have the announcement for Board meetings.

The Superintendent closed by thanking staff and students for their perseverance and the hope that we continue to keep everyone safe while providing an appropriate education.

- Mr. Iglesia thanked the Superintendent for the update on the High School construction project and provided an update from the SDA meeting which took place on February 2, 2022.



Dear Ann Marie Falzarano:

The Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund (TPAF) at its meeting of November 10, 2021 considered and approved your application for Ordinary Disability retirement benefits effective October 1, 2021 under Option B pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:66-39 and relevant case law.

Changes to your application should be made through MBOS; however, if you are unable to make the change through MBOS, you must provide a written statement to the Retirement Bureau within 30 days from the date of board approval or the date of retirement, whichever is later.

Once the Board approves a member for a disability retirement allowance; the member's retirement application shall not be withdrawn, cancelled, or amended to a later retirement date than the date specified in the approved retirement allowance.

If a member continues to receive a salary beyond the effective date of retirement, no retirement benefits shall be paid for the period where the member received salary and no salary or service credit shall be provided for the service rendered after the approved effective date of retirement. In addition, the employer shall be required to complete an updated Certification of Service and Final Salary.

The statute permits the Board of Trustees to require a disability retiree to undergo medical examinations to determine if they continue to be totally and permanently disabled and therefore eligible for continued receipt of a disability retirement allowance.

If in the future you consider returning to a position either in private industry or public employment, be advised that your retirement allowance as a disability retiree is subject to adjustment if your earnings from employment after retirement exceed the difference between the pension portion of your retirement allowance and the salary attributable to your former position.

Pension laws require reenrollment of a retiree under certain conditions. Retirees needing guidance on returning to employment should visit our web site at: www.nj.gov/treasury/pensions and refer to the Fact Sheet on post-retirement employment restrictions. Retirees needing additional clarification should contact the Division to determine the impact a return to employment would have on their disability retirement benefits.

5561 USE OF PHYSICAL RESTRAINT AND SECLUSION TECHNIQUES FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

The Board of Education strives to provide a safe, caring atmosphere that supports all students in the least restrictive environment. On occasion, during an emergency, (emergency is defined as a student posing a physical threat to himself or others) a situation may arise making it necessary to temporarily restrain or seclude a student in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:46-13.4 through 13.7.]

A school district, an educational services commission, or an approved private school for students with disabilities (APSSD), or other Board of Education approved educational placements for students with or without disabilities, that utilizes physical restraint on students shall ensure that:

1. Physical restraint is used only in an emergency in which the student is exhibiting behavior that places the student or others in immediate physical danger;
 - “State defines physical restraint as the use of a personal restriction that immobilizes or reduces the ability of a student to move all or a portion of his or her body.”
 - “State law defines seclusion as the involuntary confinement of a student alone in a room or area from which the student is physically prevented from leaving, but does not include timeout.”
 - “Emergency is defined as a situation in which the pupil’s behavior poses a threat of imminent physical harm to him/herself or others or imminent, serious property destruction.”



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Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion Techniques for Students with Disabilities

3. Staff members who are involved in the restraint of a student receive training in safe techniques for physical restraint from an entity determined by the Board of Education to be qualified to provide such training, and that the training is updated at least annually;
4. The parent of a student is immediately notified when physical restraint is used on the student. This notification may be by telephone or electronic communication. A post-incident written notification report of the incident of physical restraint shall be provided to the parent written by the building principal within forty-eight hours of the occurrence of the incident;
5. A student must be seen by the school nurse immediately following the restraint to the great extent possible or within 24 hours of the incident during school days, excluding weekends.
6. Each incident in which physical restraint is used is carefully and continuously visually monitored to ensure it was used in accordance with established procedures set forth in Policy and Regulation 5561 – Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion Techniques for Students, developed in conjunction with the entity that trains staff in safe techniques for physical restraint, in order to protect the safety of the child and others; and
7. Each incident in which physical restraint is used is documented in writing in sufficient detail to enable staff to use this information to develop or modify the behavior intervention plan at the next student intervention team meeting or Individualized Education Program **(IEP)** meeting if warranted. The team including a building administrator will convene to debrief within 24 hours of the incident during the school day, excluding weekends.



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Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion Techniques for Students with Disabilities

A school district, an educational services commission, and an APSSD or other Board of Education approved educational placements for students with or without disabilities, shall attempt to minimize the use of physical restraints through inclusion of positive behavior supports in the student's behavior intervention plans developed by the student intervention team meeting or Individualized Education Program (IEP) meeting, if warranted.

A school district, an educational services commission, or an APSSD or other Board of Education approved educational placements for students with or without disabilities, that utilizes seclusion techniques on students shall ensure that:

1. A seclusion technique is used on a student only in an emergency in which the student is exhibiting behavior that places the student or others in immediate physical danger;
2. Each incident in which a seclusion technique is used is carefully and continuously visually monitored to ensure it was used in accordance with established procedures set forth in Policy and Regulation 5561 – Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion Techniques for Students, developed in conjunction with the entity that trains staff in safe techniques for physical restraint, in order to protect the safety of the child and others; and
3. Each incident in which a seclusion technique is used is documented in writing in sufficient detail to enable the staff to use this information to develop or improve the behavior intervention plan at the next student intervention team meeting or Individualized Education Program (IEP) meeting if warranted.

A school district, an educational services commission, and an APSSD or other Board of Education approved educational placements for students with or without disabilities, shall attempt to minimize the use of seclusion techniques through inclusion of positive behavior supports in the student's behavior intervention plans developed by the student intervention team meeting or Individualized Education Program (IEP) meeting if warranted.



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Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion Techniques for Students with Disabilities

The New Jersey Department of Education shall establish guidelines for school districts, educational services commissions, and APSSDs or other Board of Education approved educational placements for students with or without disabilities, to ensure a review process is in place to examine the use of physical restraints or seclusion techniques in emergency situations, and for the repeated use of these methods for an individual child, within the same classroom, or by a single individual. The review process shall include educational, clinical, and administrative personnel. Pursuant to the review process the student's IEP team may, as deemed appropriate, determine to revise the behavior intervention plan or classroom supports, and a school district, educational services commission, or APSSD may determine to revise a staff member's professional development plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:46-13.7.

The Superintendent or designee may gather input from school staff members and parents of students with disabilities on this Policy and Regulation. All students with disabilities and their parents shall be afforded the procedural safeguards provided by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

The Superintendent or designee shall annually inform parents of students with disabilities about the Board's Policy regarding restraint and seclusion.

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The Board of Education authorizes the establishment of petty cash funds in accordance with this policy. The Board directs the implementation of appropriate controls to protect the funds from abuse.

The Board hereby establishes imprest petty cash funds in the care of the following persons and in the following amounts:

Life Skill/Transitions IEP Program	Director of Special Education	\$1,000 to \$2,000 maximum	\$35 per student per month

Petty cash funds may be disbursed only for the immediate payment of comparatively small expenditures and may not be used to circumvent the regular purchasing procedures of this district. Each request for petty cash funds must be in a written document that is signed by the person making the request; supporting documents, if any, will be affixed to the request.

In addition, the Board of Education authorizes establishment of petty cash in the following amounts:

Special Services (to be used for Life Skills/Transitions IEP Program) - \$1,000 to \$2,000 maximum allotment per school year with a maximum individual expenditure of \$35 per month per student. The teacher in charge of the Life Skills/Transition program will request the amount needed each month from the Director of Special Education. The teacher in charge will be responsible for all accounting procedures associated with the disbursement of funds, such as receipts and records per student and per expenditure. The teacher in charge of the Life Skills/Transition program will turn in receipts after the completion of the activity to the Director of Special Education to



keep for accounting purposes and will return any unused funds to the Director of Special Education.

The Director of Special Education of a petty cash fund shall submit to the Board Secretary a request for replenishment when the moneys available in the fund have declined to fifty percent or less of the authorized amount of the fund. The Board Secretary shall prepare a voucher for approval by the Board. The voucher will include disbursement slips to support the amount of the replenishment and its allocation to any account.

The petty cash box must be secured daily. All petty cash funds will be closed out for audit at the end of the school year, and unused funds will be returned to the depository. The Director of Special Education of each fund will report to the Board on amounts disbursed from the fund not less than once each year.

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Gifted and Talented Students

2464 GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to identify gifted and talented students within the school district and to provide these students with appropriate instructional adaptations and services. To that end, the Board directs each such student in the school district be identified and offered an appropriate educational program and services.

For purposes of this Policy, “gifted and talented students” means students who possess or demonstrate high levels of ability in one or more content areas when compared to their chronological peers in the district and who require modification of their educational program if they are to achieve in accordance with their capabilities.

For the purpose of this Policy, “instructional adaptation” means an adjustment or modification to instruction enabling a student who is gifted and talented to participate in, benefit from, and demonstrate knowledge and application of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards in one or more content areas at the instructional level of the student, not just the student’s grade level.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall ensure that the appropriate instructional adaptations are designed for students who are gifted and talented.

The Superintendent or designee will develop procedures for an ongoing Kindergarten through grade twelve identification process for gifted and talented students that includes multiple measures in order to identify student strengths in intellectual ability, creativity, or a specific academic area. The district shall ensure equal access to a continuum of gifted and talented education services. The identification process shall include consideration of all students, including those who are English language learners and those with Individualized Education Plans or 504 Plans.



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Gifted and Talented Students

The Superintendent or designee will develop and document appropriate curricular and instructional modifications used for gifted and talented students indicating content, process, products, and learning environments, and including, but not limited to, additional education activities such as academic competitions, guest speakers, and lessons with a specialist.

The Superintendent or designee will take into consideration the Gifted Programming Standards, Position Statements, and White Papers of the National Association for Gifted Children in identifying and serving gifted and talented students.

The district will provide the time and resources to develop, review, and enhance instructional tools with modifications for helping gifted and talented students acquire and demonstrate mastery of the required knowledge and skills specified by the standards at the instructional level of the student.

The district will actively assist and support professional development for teachers, educational services staff, and school leaders in the area of gifted and talented instruction.

The district shall file with the New Jersey Department of Education Coordinator for Gifted and Talented Services a report by October 1, 2020 and thereafter on a schedule that coincides with the school district's New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) review pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7A-11. The report shall include, but not be limited to, the gifted and talented continuum of services, policies, and procedures implemented in the school district; the total number of students receiving gifted and talented services in each grade level Kindergarten through grade twelve disaggregated by race, gender, special education designation, and English language learner designation; the professional development opportunities provided for teachers, educational services staff, and school leaders about gifted and talented students, their needs, and educational development; and the number of staff employed by the school district whose job responsibilities include identification of and providing services to gifted and talented students. Programs for gifted and talented students will be periodically evaluated for their continuing efficacy and adjusted accordingly.



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Gifted and Talented Students

The parent of any student identified as gifted or talented shall be consulted regarding any program designed to address the student's particular needs.

An individual who believes the district has not complied with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:35-34 et seq. may file a complaint with the Board of Education. This policy for filing a complaint shall be linked to the homepage of the Board's Internet website. The Board shall issue a decision, in writing, to affirm, reject, or modify the district's action in the matter. The individual may then file a petition of appeal of the Board's written decision to the Commissioner of Education through the Office of Controversies and Disputes in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:6-9 and the procedures set forth in State Board of Education regulations.

The district shall make detailed information available on its website regarding the policies and procedures used to identify students as gifted and talented and the continuum of services offered to gifted and talented students. The information shall include the criteria used for consideration for eligibility for the gifted and talented services, including the multiple measures used in the identification process to match a student's needs with services, and any applicable timelines in the identification process.
